#### New Site & Dome Decommissioning

An update on the progress of construction of the new site was presented at our AGM. We will play the whole of the 2024/2025 season on our two grass greens and expect to be fully operational at the new premises for the 2025/2026 season.

The Dome decommissioning commenced on the 12 June. Site construction fencing has been established which has impacted the carpark. Electrical and water systems have been disconnected and Badge, our builders, have established their site office and storeroom in the car park.

On 17 June we saw the removal of the first bolt of the dome. Subject to weather the whole job should be completed by the end of August.

Please note that during this process the Club will remain open, as will the greens, weather permitting. The entry to the club will be through the gate at the end of the Clubrooms on South Road.

It is expected that practical completion of the new site is planned at this stage for the end of March 2025.
